

The CPD programme for *SAMJ* is administered by Medical Practice Consulting. CPD questionnaires must be completed online at www.mpconsulting.co.za.

Please note: The change in CPD question format comes from the accreditation bodies, who have informed us that CPD questionnaires must consist of a minimum of 5 questions, 80% of which should be MCQs with a minimum of 4 options and only 20% of which may now be in the form of 'True or false' answers.

MCQs may be of 'single correct answer' or 'multiple correct answer' format. Where the question states that more than one answer is correct, mark more than one of a, b, c or d (anything from two to all answers may be correct). For example, in Question 2, if you think that a, b and c are correct (note that these are not necessarily the correct answers), mark each of these on the answer form. Where the question states that only one answer is correct, mark the single answer that you think is correct.

The characteristics of dermatology inpatients seen at the quaternary Inkosi Albert Luthuli Central Hospital in Durban, South Africa, over a 5-year period – 2015 - 2020

Regarding the characteristics of dermatology inpatients (more than one answer is correct):

- Inpatients in other disciplines can benefit from dermatology consultation services.
- In South Africa (SA), older dermatology patients are admitted compared with developing countries such as Australia and the UK.
- c. Dermatitis or eczema were the most frequent indications for admission in Australia.
- d. Atopic dermatitis, extensive psoriasis and severe drug reactions accounted for most dermatology admissions in Cape Town, SA.

Pancreatic cancer mortality in South Africa: A case-controlled study Regarding pancreatic cancer (more than one answer is correct):

- a. In SA, pancreatic cancer ranked seventh among all cancer deaths in 2020 in both sexes.
- b. Pancreatic cancer was the sixth leading case of death among males in SA and the seventh among females.
- Between 1997 and 2016, the number of cases of pancreatic cancer in SA has hugely increased.
- d. Approximately 80 85% of pancreatic cancer cases are diagnosed in stage IV, when it is impossible for patients to benefit from curative surgery.

- d. Autoimmune polyendocrinopathy syndromes are a group of rare heterogeneous conditions that have the common feature of organ-specific autoantibodies and T lymphocyte autoreactivity.
