undergraduate research can be. It should just be pictures. The image needs to have the following colour schemes: - Colour 1 (Red 0 Green 0 Blue 0) - Colour 2 (Red 74 Green 161 Blue 212) - Colour 3 (Red 101 Green 101 Blue 101) - Colour 4 (Red 255 Green 255 Blue 255)
